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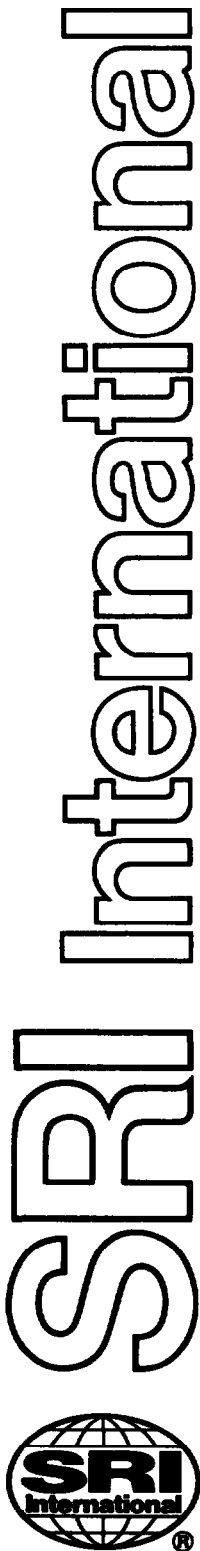
Abstract

This report covers the technologies and economics for the production of specialty plastic films. Investment and production costs are presented for manufacturing the following specialty films:

- Microporous films--PP and PET
- Fluoropolymer films--FEP and PFA
- Polycarbonate film (PC)
- Polyimide film (PI).

The report also reviews the current status of the plastic film industry.
